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RESOLUTION NO. 2012-258

RESOLUTION IMPOSING NO OBJECTION TO STA. CLARA POWER CORPORATION THRU ITS VICE PRESIDENT VIGILANT G. DAVID FOR THE CONDUCT OF ACTIVITIES RELATIVE TO THE PROPOSED 8MW LOWER CATUIRAN HYDRO ELECTRIC POWER PLANT PROJECT TO BE PUT UP ALONG THE CATUIRAN (BAGTO) RIVER COVERED BY IP COMMUNITIES IN THIS MUNICIPALITY, SUBJECT TO COMPLIANCE TO RELEVANT LAWS ON RENEWABLE ENERGY, AND THE PROVISIONS OF THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH NATIONAL COMMISSION ON INDIGENOUS PEOPLES (NCIP) AND THE MANGYAN ALANGAN INDIGENOUS PEOPLES/INDIGENOUS COMMUNITIES (IP/ICs).

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9513, "An Act Promoting the Development, Utilization and Commercialization of Renewable Energy Resources and for Other Purposes", otherwise known as the Renewable Energy Act of 2008, promotes to accelerate the exploration and development of renewable energy resources such as, but not limited to, biomass, solar, wind, hydro, geothermal and ocean energy resources to achieve energy self-reliance, to reduce the country's dependence on fossil fuels and thereby enhance the country's exposure to price fluctuations in international markets, the effects of which is seen down to interest rates of our economy;

WHEREAS, the climate law envisions the promotion and utilization of renewable energy sources as a viable alternative to fossil fuel, thus reducing carbon emissions and mitigating climate change; and in alignment with the principles of health and the environment;

WHEREAS, Republic Act 7156, otherwise known as the Sta. Clara Power Corporation Act, is an act creating incident to the formation of the Sta. Clara Power Corporation, further declares that only hydroelectric power plant shall be built in the municipality of Naujan and its environs, for a wide range of benefits conducive to the development of the community, to provide for power needs to local industries and users;

WHEREAS, Sta. Clara Power Corporation (SCPC) represents itself as a dynamic independent power producing corporation with preference in hydro power development, an organization registered and operating in accordance with Philippine laws with principal address at Highway 51 Plaza, Stanford, 10080, Mandaluyong

WHEREAS, through the privatization program of the Philippine Government's Power Sector Assets and Liabilities Management Corporation (PSALM), SCPC has acquired the 1.2 MW Loboc Mini-Hydro Power Plant in the island Province of Bohol and now also holds 50% ownership of the 0.8 MW Amlan Mini Hydro Power Plant in Negros Occidental;

WHEREAS, SCPC is now working on the Proposed Catubiran 8MW Mini Hydroelectric Power Project along Catubiran (Bogel) River, covering three barangays of Mognan, Oriental Mindoro, Banulan, Sulit and Caburn, all in communities;

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Catubiran Mini Hydroelectric Power Plant is to provide a dependable water supply for the Catubiran River of power generation with an installed capacity of 2X4 MW;

WHEREAS, pursuant to RA 8972
Flights Act of 1997 and other related
securing the free and prior informed
cultural communities/indigenous peo-
ple right of the ICC/IP to the management
of land and resources within their ancestral
territories;

otherwise known as the Indigenous Peoples
Act of 1997 it is significant that the process of
consent (PICC) of the concerned Indigenous
peoples will always accord to the overriding
development, use and utilization of their own
territories and resources;

WHEREAS, as required by law, no permit for the exploration, utilization and development of natural resources or any portion of any ancestral domain shall be granted or renewed by the concerned government agency without the free and prior informed consent of affected Indigenous peoples/Indigenous cultural communities;

WHEREAS, with the growing demand for energy which our current power producers could not adequately supply, there is an increasing necessity to develop new renewable energy resources to amply provide residential, commercial and industrial consumers of the municipality with reliable and reasonably-priced electricity;

WHEREAS, in order to encourage alternative, clean, reliable and efficient provisions of the Renewable Energy known as Mini-Hydroelectric Power development of Lower Catubiran (Bogel) initiative to develop and operate the

SCPC in its discretion, i.e. the development of resources of energy, in pursuance to the Act of 1992, and Republic Act 7156 otherwise known as this August Body supports the Lower Catubiran Mini-Hydroelectric Power Plant Project, in which:

BE IT, THEREFORE RESOLVED, to instruct the Assistant Vice President of Sta. Clara Power Corporation (SCPC) thru its Assistant Vice President Vigilant David to conduct the conduct of activities relative to the Proposed 8MW Lower Catubiran Hydroelectric Power Plant Project to be put up along the Catubiran (Bogel) River covering three barangays in this municipality, subject to compliance of relevant laws on renewable energy and the provisions of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the National Commission on Indigenous Peoples (NCIP) and the Indigenous Peoples/Indigenous Communities (IPs/ICCs).

BE IT, FURTHER RESOLVED, to furnish copy of this resolution the Assistant Vice President of Sta. Clara Power Corporation Vigilant David in his office address at Highway 1 Pura, Benford St. cor. EDSA, Mandaluyong City, for his information and appropriate action.

BE IT, FURTHERMORE RESOLVED, to furnish copy of this resolution, the Municipal Mayor Honorable Maria Angeles C. Geron for her information.
