23 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – Madam Presiding Officer, I would like to ask the estimated fund for this
24 years calamity fund at kung ano ang ginagastos natin sa ngayon?

25 JOERY M. GEROLEO – For the entire year is P9M. Ang pinaggamitan sa capital outlay ay
26 procurement ng folding beds, stockpile na bigas.

27 COUN. MARA EDAMZEL L. DUDAS – Motion of privilege, may we request the persons who repair
28 the roof na kung maari ay later na lang, dahil hindi marinig ang usapan.

29 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – One of our staff may please to request na mamaya na ituloy
30 ang pagre-repair.

31 (Staff went out to request the persons on the roof to stop for a while.)

32 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – Ang Calamity ba na ito ay QRF?

33 JOERY M. GEROLEO – P2.7M ang QRF.

34 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – Food at sardines ang pinaggamitan pero sa pagkain ay konti lang.

35 JOERY M. GEROLEO – Ang 30% ng calamity fund ay mandated by law as QRF.

36 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – Gaano karami agad ang stockpile?

37 JOERY M. GEROLEO – 100 cavans na bigas. Iyong QRF ay magagamit lang kung may
38 declaration ng calamity. Iniwasan natin na kung marami ang stockpile ay uumukin lamang. Ang
39 NFA ay 100 cavans lang per day ang pwedeng bilhin sa kanila.

40 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – Wala ba kayong advice ng bagyo? May communication ba kayong
41 natanggap mula sa PDRRMO?

42 JOERY M. GEROLEO – Pabago-bago ang forecast ng PAGASA ng bagyo ang sabi nila ay nasa
43 Bicol ng Sunday, pumasok sa PAR ay Sunday na.

44 ABSTENENCIA C. DE GUZMAN – Umorder kami ng Monday pero hindi na nag-release ang NFA.
45 Monday ay nag-meeting na.

46 JOERY M. GEROLEO – 400 cavans talaga ang gusto naming i-order pero hindi i-release ng NFA

- 1 dahil may policy sila. Noong time ng Ruby may stockpile na tayo.
- 2 ABSTENENCIA C. DE GUZMAN – Ang usapan with the Liga ng mga Barangay na sa first day, ang
- 3 stockpile ng barangay ang kukunan, at sa 2nd day saka pa lang ang municipal.
- 4 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – Total damage sa Naujan, ilan ba ang totally damaged?
- 5 JOERY M. GEROLEO – 8,400 ang report ng damaged houses sa 52 barangays, may 18 barangays
- 6 na hindi pa kasama. Iyong kinukuhan natin bigas, sardines, noodles, iyon po ay doon ibabawas
- 7 sa P2M.
- 8 COUN. LEO G. DE VILLA – Ang barangay ba ay naging ready?
- 9 JOERY M. GEROLEO – May mga report naman po na meron silang stockpile.
- 10 COUN. LEO G. DE VILLA – Maraming lumikas sa mga barangay, hindi ko naramdaman na
- 11 mayroong ayuda mula sa pamahalaan para magkaroon din ng command ang bawat
- 12 barangay.
- 13 JOERY M. GEROLEO – Pwede tayong bumili pero pahirapan naman sa pagbili. Kalakasan na ng
- 14 bagyo noong December 15 at inabot na ng bagyo sa Curva ang ating bigas. Pwede po na i-full
- 15 blast ang 30% QRF ang problema ay wala nang mabili.
- 16 COUN. LEO G. DE VILLA – Ang naging problema kasi last year ay ang COA.
- 17 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – Wala kasing declaration last year.
- 18 JOERY GEROLEO – Hindi din po kasi tayo mag-stockpiling ng madami dahil for bidding na ito.
- 19 Kapag more than P100,000.00 ay for bidding pa.
- 20 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – May MOA naman tayo sa NFA during calamity. Bakit nagti-tyaga pa
- 21 tayo sa NFA ay pwede naman pala sa iba dahil ibi-bid din pala?
- 22 COUN. GREAT M. DELOS REYES – Kapag ang halaga ay lalagpas ng P100,000.00 dadaan ito sa
- 23 bidding. Kung bibili sa labas magkakaroon din ng bidding. Ang forecast ng PAGASA ay tatama
- 24 dito sa atin ng Wednesday, 12:00 p.m. pero tumama ng Martes at 10:00 a.m. So, wala na tayong
- 25 magagawa.
- 26 COUN. LEO G. DE VILLA – Bakit tayo matatakot sa COA kung tatama naman sa atin ang bagyo.
- 27 Paano kung kailangan ng mga tao? Depensahan na lang natin.
- 28 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – So, nagamit na ang 70% para sa preparedness. Stockpile na
- 29 140,000 na bigas, noodles at sardines. May magagamit pa tayo na P2.7M, ilan na ang nagamit
- 30 out of that?
- 31 JOERY M. GEROLEO – Ang nagamit ay about P500,000.00.
- 32 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – Ilan pa ang kailangan natin?
- 33 ABSTENENCIA C. DE GUZMAN – Mga P3M pa ang kailangan for food.
- 34 FLOOR LEADER – Kulang na tayo ng P300,000.00 para sa food assistance. Magkano po ang
- 35 kailangan para sa shelter?
- 36 ABSTENENCIA C. DE GUZMAN – P26M ang kailangan for shelter assistance para sa 52 barangays.
- 37 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – May P5.7M tayo for next year.
- 38 COUN. LEO G. DE VILLA – Papaano ang preparedness. Hindi pwedeng gamitin lahat ang pondo
- 39 by next year.
- 40 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – P29M ang kailangan natin sa ngayon and yet P2.7M lang ang
- 41 mayroon tayo ngayon.
- 42 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – We still need P29M, P3M for food and P26M for shelter
- 43 assistance. Question from the Chair, mula sa anong district iyong hindi pa nakakapag-submit ng
- 44 report? Ano ang sitwasyon ng area, passable na ba?
- 45 JOERY M. GEROLEO – Motorsiklo pa lang po ang pwede. Ang Barangay San Andres at Barangay
- 46 Malvar ay hindi pa po napupuntahan.

- 1 ABSTENENCIA DE GUZMAN – Mayroong tayong apat na casualty.
- 2 COUN. EDGAR IBRAHIM C. LLAMAR, MD. – Hindi ba naisama ang Metolza at Evangelista?
- 3 ABSTENENCIA C. DE GUZMAN – Metolza ay wala pang report, pero sa Barangay Evangelista ay
- 4 mayroon na.
- 5 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. - Kaugnay ng Supplemental Investment Program No. 3, may
- 6 pangangailangan ba talaga para i-reconsider ng MDC. Ano ba ang dapat kalagyan ng
- 7 pondo?
- 8 ABSTENENCIA C. DE GUZMAN – Food at pagpapaayos ng bahay, iyong seeds ay later na lang.
- 9 Iyon ang pinakakailangan nila sa ngayon ay food at materials assistance.
- 10 COUN. LEO G. DE VILLA – Iyon ba ay cash?
- 11 ABSTENENCIA C. DE GUZMAN – Ang plano namin ay materials assistance. Itinatanong din naming
- 12 kung saan galing ang bahay.
- 13 COUN. GREAT M. DELOS REYES – Ano ba ang plano sa pamimigay? Paano ang pagkukwenta ng
- 14 damages?
- 15 ABSTENENCIA C. DE GUZMAN – P3,000.00 sa totally damaged, P1,000.00 sa partially damaged.
- 16 May pipirmahan sila na form na kung wala ito hindi sila mabibigyan. Bago matapos ang
- 17 assessment ay one and one half (1 ½) months kapag sa atin galing ang pondo.
- 18 COUN. GREAT M. DELOS REYES – Talagang kailangan ng tao ang ayuda, huwag na itong
- 19 patagalin.
- 20 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – Ilan ang tao ninyo? Sa partial report ay 8,412 in.52 barangays.
- 21 ABSTENENCIA C. DE GUZMAN – 10 kami kasama ang 3 job order personnel, makikipag-
- 22 coordinate kami sa Regional Office.
- 23 COUN. GREAT M. DELOS REYES – Iyong para sa totally damaged, pwede na bang mag-release?
- 24 Baka pwede naman na mas mapabilis ang pagproseso ng tulong sa mga barangay.
- 25 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – Sa 52 barangays ay P29M ang kailangan, pero ang ating
- 26 pondo ay kulang.
- 27 ABSTENENCIA C. DE GUZMAN – Ang priority namin ay food packs pwede namang unahin natin
- 28 ang totally damaged.
- 29 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – Tama sa butas, sala sa batas.
- 30 COUN. EDGAR IBRAHIM C. LLAMAR, MD. – Previously, hindi tayo nadadamage ng ganito dapat
- 31 quick response nagiging slow response. Kailangan ng tulong ng kababayan natin wala silang
- 32 makain. We have to do something immediately.
- 33 ABSTENENCIA C. DE GUZMAN – Hindi tayo mareleasan ng 400 cavans na pina-purchase natin.
- 34 COUN. EDGAR IBRAHIM C. LLAMAR, MD. – Iyong MOA ba with NFA dito lang ba iyon sa Naujan?
- 35 JOERY GEROLEO – Sa Calapan NFA Buying Station.
- 36 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – (Reads provisions of the MOA with NFA.) Kung magkakaroon
- 37 ng revision sa SIP, sa shelter assistance ilalagay not on food.
- 38 ABSTENENCIA C. DE GUZMAN – Yes po.
- 39 COUN. EDGAR IBRAHIM C. LLAMAR, MD. – We have to do something, ineffective ang NFA. Dapat
- 40 gumawa tayo ng paraan dahil nagugutom ang ating mga kababayan. Bakit kailangan pa ng
- 41 approval ng accountant? We have to visit our MOA with NFA, we have to learn from our
- 42 mistakes. Maraming shortcomings, sa MOA ay tali na tayo na 100 cavans lang, mayroon pa
- 43 bang pamamaraan para makaresponde ang munisipyo? Is there any other way for the Local
- 44 Chief Executive para makabili agad ng bigas para makaresponde ang munisipyo?
- 45 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – Maybe makapag-MOA tayo with private individuals idadaan
- 46 sa proseso ng bidding process, more papers ito. Government to government, MOA with NFA is

- 1 the fastest way. May delay ba sa pagkuha sa NFA?
2 JOERY GEROLEO – Wala po, nakapila lang.
3 COUN. EDGAR IBRAHIM C. LLAMAR, MD. – Bakit nagkakaroon ng delay sa payment?
4 JOERY GEROLEO – Walang delay sa payment. But last year merong nag-suggest sa barangay na
5 gamitin muna ang QRF nila.
6 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – Kung maa-approve ang budget ng barangay, pwedeng
7 gamitin sa January 1 ay QRF nila.
8 PRESIDING OFFICER – Kung wala nang katanungan, maraming salamat po sa inyong pagdalo sa
9 aming sesyon.
10 ABSTENENCIA C. DE GUZMAN/JOERY GEROLEO – Maraming salamat din po.
11 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – Madam Presiding Officer, I move for the lifting of the
12 suspension of the rules of procedures.
13 PRESIDING OFFICER – On motion of Floor Leader, the suspension of the rules of procedures is now

29 **COMMITTEE REPORT/S:**
30 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – Madam Presiding Officer, this refers to the Supplemental
31 Investment Plan No. 3, Series of 2015 submitted to our office on December 14, 2015 amounting to
32 P5,937,201.00. During the caucus earlier, we suggested to consider the Supplemental Investment
33 Plan No. 3, to be returned to the MDC to make it more responsive to the needs of our barangays
34 devastated by the typhoon.
35 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – The Distinguished Councilor from Sampaguila, is recognized.
36 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – On my part I object to return it to the proper authority. Being one of
37 the members of this August Body, I am objecting.
38 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – This was referred to the Committee on Finance, Budget and
39 Appropriations and we could report this. Then, I called for a caucus whether we could allow to
40 reconsider the Supplemental Investment Plan No. 3. It's the consensus of the majority.
41 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – But its in the session hindi nagkaroon ng committee hearing nag-
42 caucus pero nag-object ako.
43 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – My motion is to consider.
44 COUN. EDGAR IBRAHIM C. LLAMAR, MD. – There was a letter.
45 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – There was no committee hearing that's why it is verbal report.
46 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – The recommendation is only to call the MSWDO and MDRRMO para

1 matukoy kung magkano ang kailangan.

2 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – We are preparing for Quick Response Fund estimated at
3 P26M for 52 barangays.

4 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – We have P2M for QRF na hindi nauubos, bakit hindi gastusin? Kulang
5 pa rin ng report ang 18 barangays.

6 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – The Distinguished Lady Councilor from Sampaguita, is
7 recognized.

8 COUN. MARA EDAMZEL L. DUDAS - The question is about the proseso ng pagre-report. Maaari ba
9 nating patapusin ang reporting ng subject matter, bilang Chairman ng Committee on Rules?
10 Then we can clarify and interpellate.

11 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – I agree to the motion of the Distinguished Coun. Mara
12 Edamzel L. Dudas. If there's an objection we can take it into voting. This is a verbal report, this
13 can be done. At pinapayagan natin itong verbal report.

14 COUN. MARA EDAMZEL L. DUDAS – What is the consequence kung tinanggap natin ang report?
15 Pero ang hindi ibig sabihin ay gagawa ng resolution ito?

16 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – For adoption on the floor and not on the committee.

17 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – The recommendation is to return this subject matter to the
18 Mayor's Office.

19 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – Can we ask our members, who are in favor that the subject
20 matter be reported? The Distinguished Councilor from Sta. Isabel?

21 COUN. LEO G. DE VILLA – Madam Presiding Officer, I agree.

22 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – The Distinguished Lady Councilor from Sampaguita?

23 COUN. MARA EDAMZEL L. DUDAS – Madam Presiding Officer, I'm not against the reporting.

24 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – The Distinguished Councilor from Sampaguita?

25 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY - I submit that the subject matter be reported.

26 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – As Vice Chairman, I agree that this subject matter be
27 reported.

28 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – Madam Presiding Officer, I recommend to return the subject
29 matter.

30 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – Is this the recommendation of the committee? To return the subject
31 matter to the MDC?

32 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – The recommendation is to return the SIP no. 3 to the MDC to
33 make it more responsive to the needs of these affected by the typhoon.

34 COUN. EDGAR IBRAHIM C. LLAMAR, MD. – Madam Presiding Officer, can I ask some of the
35 members of the Committee on Finance if they agree.

36 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – The said recommendation shall be put into voting.

37 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – Madam Presiding Officer, I object to return this to the proper
38 authority.

39 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – Madam Presiding Officer, I move to put this into voting.

40 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – I declare a five minute recess.

22 *(Session is resumed at 4:20 p.m.)*

23 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – Session is now resumed. The Distinguished Lady Councilor
24 from Sampaguita is recognized.

25 COUN. MARA EDAMZEL L. DUDAS – Madam Presiding Officer, what is really the recommendation
26 of the Chair?

27 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – For adoption of the report. The Distinguished Councilor from
28 Sta. Isabel is recognized.

29 COUN. LEO G. DE VILLA – Madam Presiding Officer, I agree that the report be adopted.

30 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – Madam Presiding Officer, I object. First, no committee hearing.
31 Second hindi iyan ang makasasagot sa pangangailangan ng mamamayan, ang P6M gamot
32 kabayo. Hindi pwedeng madaliin. By 2016, may pondo naman tayo na pwedeng gamitin.

33 COUN. MARA EDAMZEL L. DUDAS – Hindi muna. Naintindihan ko ang ipinaglalaman pero
34 kailangan na i-exhaust muna ang available fund, may 70% preparedness na unexpended pa at
35 pwedeng gamitin by 2016. Kung kung lilipat naman ito, hindi ba apektado ang opisina na
36 aalisan ng pondo. At ang MDC ang dapat mag-initiate, hindi sa atin, para hindi magkaroon ng
37 encroaching.

38 COUN. EDGAR IBRAHIM C. LLAMAR, MD – Walang klarong committee hearing.

39 COUN. MARA EDAMZEL L. DUDAS – Hindi pwedeng gawing rason na sabihin na walang
40 committee hearing dahil allowed naman ito. Nakakahiya naman, sa legality lang. Allowed
41 naman po tayo na verbal committee report.

42 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – Kaya sinabi ko ay dahil may schedule tayo.

43 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – Ito naman ay pinapayagan na mag-verbal report.

44 COUN. GREAT M. DELOS REYES – Ito man ang sinasabi ng iba, ito po ay opinyon nya, nararapat
45 tanggapin ang opinyon ng bawat isa.

46 COUN. EDGAR IBRAHIM C. LLAMAR, MD – Alam natin na may resource persons tayo kapag may

1 committee hearing. The MDRRMO and MSWDO is not enough as of now, wala tayong klarong
2 report. Ang kailangan ng tao ay pagkain. Marami pa sigurong mahahanap na pondo. I am not
3 in favor.

4 COUN. JOJO B. DE VILLA – Alam ko na maganda ang intensyon ng sponsor, may P2.2M pa tayo
5 na hindi nagagastos. Mas maganda na ayusin muna ang plano na pinupuntirya by 2016
6 pwedeng gamitin na uli ang pondo. Ako ay hindi favor.

7 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – Madam Presiding Officer, I am in favor, because I believe that
8 the little needs that our departments can sacrifice will affect the needs of our constituents. Wala
9 akong nakikitang problema kung verbal report, it is allowed. I also agree that the verbal report is
10 subject to adoption, kung hindi nag-agree ang member ay mayroon dapat dissenting opinion. I
11 am requesting for reconsideration.

12 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – Four members are not in favor to adopt the report regarding
13 SIP No. 3, while three members are in favor to adopt the report. Therefore, the verbal committee
14 report is not adopted.

15 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – Madam Presiding Officer, may I be allowed to render a verbal
16 committee report regarding the Supplemental Budget of four barangays for FY 2015, namely:
17 Barangay Bancuro, Barangay Sampaguita, Barangay Poblacion II and Barangay Gamao.

18 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – You may proceed.

19 2. Coun. Candido J. Melgar, Jr., Chairman of the Committee on Finance, Budget and Appropriations,
20 renders a verbal committee report.)

21 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – Madam Presiding Officer, these supplemental budgets are
22 intended for the granting of year-end bonus and PEI of the barangays officials. Since there is an
23 issuance from the Local Finance Committee that they were informed regarding the guidelines,
24 so we find no adverse findings. As per indorsement forwarded by the Local Finance Committee
25 (LFC) these four supplemental budgets of different barangays have complied with existing
26 budgeting rules, regulations and guidelines and therefore recommended to be declared
27 operative.

7 PRESIDING OFFICER – Any clarification on the findings of the Committee? (Silence) None, what is
8 the pleasure of the Reporter?

9 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. - Madam Presiding Officer, I move for the adoption of this
10 verbal committee report.

11 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – Hearing no objection, the verbal committee report is hereby
12 adopted.

13 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – Madam Presiding Officer, I move that this subject matter be
14 included in the Calendar of Business for today's session.

15 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – Hearing no objection, on motion of the Floor Leader, the
16 subject matter is included in the Calendar of Business.

17 **CALENDAR OF BUSINESS:**

18 FLOOR LEADER – Let us recognize the Distinguished Councilor from Evangelista.

19 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – The Distinguished Councilor from Evangelista is recognized.

20 COUN. EDGAR IBRAHIM C. LLAMAR, MD. – Madam Presiding Officer, may I be allowed to read
21 the proposed Resolution Requesting Honorable City Mayor Jaime R. Fresnedi thru City Councilor
22 Coun. Stephanie Teves for Calamity Assistance for the People of Naujan Affected

23 by Typhoon Nona with Signal No. 3 during December 15, 2015, jointly with Coun. Wilson A. Viray.

24 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – You may proceed.

25 COUN. EDGAR IBRAHIM C. LLAMAR, MD. – Madam Presiding Officer, we have a proposed
26 RESOLUTION REQUESTING HONORABLE CITY MAYOR JAIME R. FRESNEDI THRU CITY COUNCILOR
27 STEPHANIE G. TEVES FOR CALAMITY ASSISTANCE FOR THE PEOPLE OF NAUJAN AFFECTED BY
28 TYPHOON NONA WITH SIGNAL NO. 3 DURING DECEMBER 15, 2015.

29 WHEREAS, the Municipality of Naujan lies in the northeastern part of Oriental Mindoro,
30 having a vast area of more than 52,200 hectares, composing 70 barangays, the biggest area in
31 the Province of Oriental Mindoro, whose the dominal industry is agriculture;

32 WHEREAS, with the occurrence of typhoon Nona, aggravated by continuous flooding in
33 many barangays, majority of the houses were damaged including poultry livestock agricultural
34 crops and insufficient food and medicines.

35 WHEREAS, it is an opportune time to seek the support of other Local Government Units for
36 the help of repair and rehabilitation of damaged houses, including assistance for food and
37 medicines within the municipality wherein the municipal funds are insufficient to provide;

38 WHEREAS, the people of Naujan, through this August Body, looks up to the funding
39 assistance and support of the Office of the City Mayor, Jaime R. Fresnedi thru City Councilor
40 Stephanie G. Teves, would favorably grant the request for the benefit of Naujenos.

41 BE IT, THEREFORE, the request Honorable City Mayor Jaime R. Fresnedi thru City Councilor
42 Stephanie G. Teves, for calamity assistance for repair and rehabilitation of damaged houses
43 including assistance for food and medicines. Madam Presiding Officer, I am open for
44 interpellation.

45 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – Any interpellation? The Distinguished Councilor from Sta.
46 Isabel is recognized.

1 COUN. LEO G. DE VILLA – Madam Presiding Officer, nandoon ang pangangailangan ng ating
2 mga kababayan, pero bakit ipinagkakait ang tulong mula sa ating kaban ng bayan. Bakit tayo
3 aasa, nganganga sa isang Konsehala at Punumbayan na hindi man lang natin
4 nakakapanayam. Bakit tayo nganganga, ni hindi natin alam kung magkano ang ibibigay sa
5 atin, hindi naman sa hinahamak natin sila.

6 COUN. EDGAR IBRAHIM C. LLAMAR, MD – Gumagawa tayo ng kaparaanan.

7 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – The Distinguished Councilor from Barcenaga, is recognized.

8 COUN. GREAT M. DELOS REYES – Alam ba ng Sponsor ang kanyang inirereport? Sapagkat
9 mayroon naman tayong sariling kaparaanan mula sa ating kaban ng bayan, gayong tayo ay
10 lalayo pa para humingi ng tulong sa ibang bayan. Bakit natin ipagdamot ang kaban ng bayan
11 gayong pwede naman nating gastusin ang sarili nating pondo?

12 COUN. EDGAR IBRAHIM C. LLAMAR, MD. – Madam Presiding Officer, ito naman ay paghingi ng
13 medical assistance.

14 (Coun. Great M. Delos Reyes walked out of the session hall.)

15 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – I declare a recess.

16 **RECESS:**

17 (Recess is declared at 4:40 p.m.)

18 **RESUMPTION:**

19 (Session is resumed at 4:50 p.m.)

20 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – Session is now resumed.

21 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – Madam Presiding Officer, I move to suspend the proceedings.

22 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – Any objection? (Silence) Hearing none, this session is
23 suspended until further notice.

24 (Session is suspended at 4:45 p.m.)

25 **CONTINUATION OF THE REGULAR SESSION ON DECEMBER 21, 2015 UNDER CALENDAR OF BUSINESS**

26 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – In the absence of our Secretary to the Sanggunian, let us
27 Appoint Marilyn O. Mortel, LLSO I to act as Secretary. The Distinguished Councilor from
28 Sampaguita is recognized.

29 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – With due respect to my compadre, if you came during the Calendar
30 of Business, you are considered absent.

31 COUN. CANDIDO J. MELGAR, JR. – Let us hear from Liga ng mga Barangay President for his
32 reason.

33 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – You may now have the floor, the Liga President Deogracias
34 U. Dela Paz, IV is recognized.

35 LIGA PRESIDENT DEOGRACIAS U. DELA PAZ, IV – Noong araw ng ating sesyon ako po ay nasa
36 emergency meeting para makapag-reproduce ng bigas para sa relief operation ng Barangay
37 Apitong, so part din po ng pagkakaroon emergency meeting ang aming Sanggunian para pag-
38 usapan iyong hindi nabigyan ng relief goods noong Thursday, mayroon kaming nakuhang relief
39 goods sa OPCEN na 140 plus which is affected families sa amin ay nasa 400 plus kaya po that
40 time noong umaga nandito ako sa Naujan, kung hindi ako nagkakamali Madam Presiding
41 Officer, nagkausap pa tayo sa labas together with Konsehal Dan. Nagpatawag ako ng
42 emergency meeting para makapagpa repack ng relief goods para makapagbigay sa more or
43 less 200 plus affected families sa aming barangay, kaya hindi ako nakarating ng ganun kaaga
44 sa session ng Monday for 1:00 pm., pumunta po ako dito, hapon na nga lang at tapos na po
45 ang session kaya umuwi na ako at dumiretso na ako pa-Calapan that time. Hindi ko po talaga
46 intensyon na hindi humabol, na hindi umattend sa sesyon, kinailangan lang po talaga ako sa

1 aking barangay. If that is the query of our Floor Leader, iyon po ang aking kadahilanan. Nais ko
2 po sanang humiling sa ating mga kasama sa Sanggunian na ako ay hindi naman totally official
3 business dahil wala akong communication sa pagpapatawag ng emergency meeting, pero
4 hinihiling ko na ako ay pahintulutan pa rin na makadalo sa sesyon na ito.

5 FLOOR LEADER – Madam Presing Officer, may we abide with the provisions under our IRP.

6 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – Mr. Chair, its under the Calendar of Business of our Internal
7 Rules of Procedures, may I request our Floor Leader to read Section 21, of our Internal Rules of
8 Procedures.

9 FLOOR LEADER – *(Reads Section 21 in the Internal Rules of Procedures in paragraph No. 4.)* "If a
10 member arrives at the start of the Calendar of Business, he shall be considered absent. However,
11 in the case of a member coming late from an official business, the Presiding Officer should
12 acknowledge and recognize his presence and attendance to the session rather than being
13 considered on official business".

14 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – Madam Presiding Officer, there is a statement and I believe the
15 statement from the Liga President is valid and considered as Official Business. I'm only
16 questioning/asking the legality why he arrived only Calendar of Business. On my point of view,
17 ako rin naman ay nagsabi dito noon, kaya lang nagiging precedent na ito, na it depends upon
18 the Body, if somebody will accept at the session if he arrives at the Calendar of Business.

19 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – The Distinguished Lady Councilor from Sampaguita is
20 recognized.

21 COUN. MARA EDAMZEL L. DUDAS – In correlation to paragraph 4 of Section 21, let us also read
22 paragraph letter a together with letter b of Section 21(a) Every member of the Sangguniang
23 Bayan shall be present in all sessions, unless expressly excluded by it or necessarily prevented
24 from doing so, by sickness, by attendance to official travel/business, or other unavoidable
25 circumstances duly reported in personal writing or by phone to the Sangguniang Bayan, through
26 the Secretary to the Sangguniang Bayan; Provided that, every authorized absence from the
27 session shall be charged to the leave credits corresponding to his absence; (b) Official Business
28 (OB) refers to the period the official or employee spends outside the office/work station to attend
29 to work or work related activities. Regarding the statement of Coun. Wilson A. Viray, there is
30 already a statement from Liga President Deogracias U. Dela Paz, IV, that he was not actually in
31 official business because there was no communication coming from him to the Secretary
32 informing that he is on OB. I believe that the act of the Liga President is not on official business
33 because he already stated however, but it's okay or I have no contention that he will be
34 allowed to attend the session.

35 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – Ang tingin ko sa paliwanang ni Liga President Deogracias U.
36 Dela Paz, IV, kaya hindi official business ang sinasabi niya kasi thru letter siya ang nagpatawag at
37 that time wala kasing signal kaya hindi sya naka-contact para makapag-inform sa ating
38 Secretary para sa pagpapasabi na hindi sya makadadalo. Siya ang nagpatawag sa barangay
39 officials kaya hindi pwedeng siya ay wala doon. Is there any objection sa attendance nya for
40 today's session

41 COUN. LEO G. DE VILLA – Madam Presiding Officer, malinaw naman ang sabi ng Liga President
42 na dalawang konsehal ang nakausap niya before the session at nagpaalam sya, hindi ba
43 pwedeng ikonsidera iyon? Di ba mas magaling na iyon kaysa dun sa tumawag ka na pero wala
44 naman samantalang personal naman kayong nag-usap.

45 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – Hearing no objection, the Liga President Deogracias U. Dela
46 Paz, IV is recognized for today's session.

1 COUN. EDGAR IBRAHIM C. LLAMAR, MD. – Madam Presiding Officer, may I know if the previous
2 Secretary stated that the Liga ng mga Barangay President is on official business or absent?

3 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – Madam Secretary, ano ang nakalagay sa roll call ng
4 nakaraang sesyon?

5 ACTING SECRETARY – It was stated on our journal that the Liga President was absent.

6 FLOOR LEADER – In paragraph 3, of Section 21. "Any member shall be considered on official
7 business during the session, if there is a general invitation to the Sangguniang Bayan, previously
8 read in the session as one of the items in the Order of Business. If the invitation is individual to the
9 members, the concerned member should present the same directly to the Secretary to the
10 Sangguniang Bayan or his designate, before or after the session is held". Considering that the
11 ABC President himself called the meeting, being the Punong Barangay and the communication
12 was down during that time, I believe that it is also a form of invitation because he himself called
13 the meeting of the barangay and stated that "the concerned member should present the same
14 directly to the Secretary to the Sangguniang Bayan or his designate, before or after the session is
15 held". So, meaning, he can produce the said invitation/communication of the said meeting after
16 the session and the session was not yet finished as of this time.

17 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – I believe na makakapag-provide ang ating Liga President
18 ng kanyang communication. The Distinguished Councilor from Evangelista is recognized.

19 COUN. EDGAR IBRAHIM C. LLAMAR, MD – How can we relate ourselves with that statement
20 during roll call because attendance is very much important. The record on our journal expresses
21 that Liga President was considered as absent.

22 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – Ganun ang record ng ating SB Secretary because he did
23 not appear at that time.

24 FLOOR LEADER – Therefore, the record will be adjusted once the Liga President will appear during
25 the Calendar of Business and once he submitted the invitation of the meeting, the record will be
26 corrected. And even all resolutions since we allowed him, otherwise we did not allow his
27 presence for today's session.

28 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – So, makakapag-provide naman siya ng copy ng invitation
29 at nag-appear naman siya during Calendar of Business. The Liga ng mga Barangay President is
30 allowed to attend the session. Let's proceed.

31 FLOOR LEADER – Before we continue, item No. 1 of Calendar of Business, it is a resolution from
32 Coun. Edgar Ibrahim C. Llamar, MD, I would like to call the attention of the SB Members because
33 we have received a letter from Local Chief Executive dated December 21, 2015. Madam
34 Presiding Officer, may I be allowed to read the content of the said letter.

35 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – You may proceed.

36 FLOOR LEADER – (Reads the communication dated December 21, 2015 regarding the
37 resubmitted Supplemental Investment Plan No. 3.)

38 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – Madam Presiding Officer, for the record purposes, may I know what
39 time and date it was received?

40 FLOOR LEADER – The communication was received on December 21, 2015, at 1:10 p.m. by one
41 of our staff.

42 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – Madam Presiding Officer, during our last session, we have approve our
43 Order of Business, the letter coming from our LCE is not included in the Order of Business, it was
44 moved and approved by SB during the last session.

45 FLOOR LEADER – Madam Presiding Officer, in Section 43. Calendar of Business (d) Urgent Matters
46 – those that may be brought before the sanggunian for immediate consideration even if not

1 listed in the calendar of business, to wit:

2 1. Matters certified to as urgent by the Municipal Mayor as evidenced by an attached official
3 certification;

4 2. Matters considered as urgent by the majority of the Sanggunian members;

5 The Calendar of Business should not bind the Sanggunian to a fixed routine. On a motion to
6 suspend the rules, items of business may be taken away from their fixed order to permit the
7 consideration of urgent matters ahead of others.

8 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – Madam Presiding Officer, Yes. I agree with that but the interpretation
9 is different from the Internal Rules of Procedures which states, that during the approval of the
10 Order of Business the subject matter is not included in our agenda and today is only a
11 continuation of our previous session held last Friday. Ang tinutukoy diyan sa Calendar of Business
12 na urgent matters pwedeng hindi na padaanin provided it was included during the Order of
13 Business.

14 FLOOR LEADER – Madam Presiding Officer, can the Gentlemen from Sampaguita specify what
15 provision state that the subject matter was to be first included in the Order of Business.

16 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – Yes, but the interpretation is not like that. Hindi ganun ang
17 interpretation. Pahabol lang yan.

18 FLOOR LEADER – And whose interpretation is accurate?

19 PRESIDING OFFICER PRO TEMPORE – The Distinguished Lady Councilor from Sampaguita is
20 recognized.

21 COUN. MARA EDAMZEL L. DUDAS – Madam Presiding Officer, regarding the letter of the
22 Municipal Mayor dated today, my interpretation is that being the Chairperson of Committee on
23 Rules is that such urgent matter may not be included in the Order of Business or Calendar of
24 Business on the next session, not the session that has being suspended and to be resumed but if it
25 was received today, December 21, it is not possible. If we are going to agree we will set another
26 session not on the same, resumption of the session or has been suspended.

27 FLOOR LEADER – Ito lang po iyong sinasabi natin, why the Local Chief Executive will request for
28 urgent communication? Because it is our last session for this year. Why we did not decide to call
29 for another session and very clear on the last paragraph that the routine depending on the
30 approval of the Sangguniang Bayan Members.

31 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – If it is the intention of our Local Chief Executive to call back the letter
32 at magpasa ng another letter, why is it hindi nagpasa noong nakaraang sesyon ay nakabagyo
33 na nun?

34 FLOOR LEADER – Because the Local Chief Executive believes that Sangguniang Bayan can
35 participate or be part of that reconsideration because we are on state of calamity. Nasa ating
36 mga kamay na ito.

37 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – That is wrong interpretation.

38 FLOOR LEADER – Interpretation by whom?

39 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – That is wrong belief.

40 FLOOR LEADER – Wrong belief by whom?

41 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – The Local Chief Executive

42 FLOOR LEADER – Please take note, Madam Secretary the statement of Coun. Wilson A. Viray that
43 there is a wrong belief mentioned.

44 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – Walang SB Members na gagawa ng plano, only the MDC or Execom
45 ang gagawa ng plano hindi ang SB. Kung nakita ninyo na nangngailangan nito bakit hindi
46 kaagad nag-convene ang Execom o ang MDC na kinakailangan i-retrieve natin ang sulat at

1 baguhin ang plano. Why is it kailangan mag-endorso ay ang SB? It is not our job. Our job is to
2 approve.

3 FLOOR LEADER – Yes, it is our job because the matters was referred to the SB, it's our duty to
4 report it to MDC thru LCE for reconsideration. We are not saying to change this into calamity
5 related supplies. We are asking for reconsideration to make SIP No. 3 responsive when programs
6 and activities will be allocated. We are just saying to return. Recommendation is to return the SIP
7 No. 3. It is the job of the MDC to re-submit the Supplemental Investment Plan. In times of
8 calamity, even the procurement law, some sections pwede silang without bidding. We can
9 purchase directly even without bidding.

10 COUN. WILSON A. VIRAY – Madam Presiding Officer, based sa statement hindi na
11 kinakailangang maghintay ng bidding?

12 COUN. MARA EDAMZEL L. DUDAS – Madam Presiding Officer, point of order lumalayo na po tayo
13 sa topic.

14 FLOOR LEADER – Madam Presiding Officer, considering there are several views that can be
15 presented today, I move that the question whether to accept the letter maybe decided by the
16 Sanggunian

17 COUN. MARA EDAMZEL L. DUDAS – Madam Presiding Officer, magkaiba po ang Calendar of
18 Business at Order of Business. Ang sinasabi ni Konsehal Dan ay Calendar of Business, ang sinasabi
19 ko naman po ay pwede naman ito kung halimbawang bukas ay magpatatag tayo ng special

28 because we are on state of calamity, that's why in-urgent ito ng ating Punumbayan. Kung

30 recognized.

31 COUN. LEO G. DE VILLA – Madam Presiding Officer, last Friday na nag-sesyon tayo, totoo naman

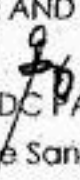
