RESOLUTION NO. 2, SERIES OF 2014

RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE PROTECTED AREA MANAGEMENT BOARD (PAMB), TOGETHER WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES (DENR) AND THE MINDORO BIODIVERSITY CONSERVATION FOUNDATION, INC (MBCFI), TO REEVALUATE THE ZONING MAP OF THE NAUJAN LAKE NATIONAL PARK

Provided that, in the meeting held by the Protected Area Management Board, the Municipal of Naujan, headed by Officer-In-Charge, Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator (OIC-MPDC) Raquelita M. Umali, has presented the profile of Barangay Montelago;

Provided that, based on the shared data and information, the following has been revealed:

- Brgy. Montelago has many residential structures and can be considered a "built-up area" and most of the land are documented private properties
- The former characteristic of the area, being of high biodiversity and rich in forestry, based on the studies conducted by the Southeast Asian Regional Center for Graduate Study in 1997, is no longer apparent if the basis is its current condition.

Provided that, following the presentation of Ms. Umali, it was agreed upon by the board, that the said Barangay is to be reclassified as a Multiple-Use Zone instead of the former classification as a Strict Protection Zone;

Provided that, the decision of the board includes the rezoning for the reclassification of the Naujan lake National Park between a Multiple-Use Zone and a Strict Protection Zone;

Thus, the motion of SB Ancito J. Villanueva of the Municipal of Pola, seconded by Barangay Captain Pedro B. Sabas of Barangay Malabo, Victoria, for the reassessment of the zoning map of Naujan Lake National by the Protected Area Management Board (PAMB), together with the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) and Mindoro Biodiversity Conservation Foundation, Inc. (MBCFI), is approved;

Also, it was decided that related to the activity to be undertaken, the resolution for the confirmation of the Naujan Lake National Park Management Plan is to be delayed.
